## Make your own biscornu



**1** Iron your two finished stitched squares on the reverse, using a low heat setting. With pins, mark the exact middle of each backstitched side. Repeat on the other square so that all eight sides are marked.



**2** Trim the excess fabric, leaving about 1cm (1/2 inch) all around, and cut off the tip of each corner. Carefully fold back the fabric along all eight edges in line with the backstitched border. Position one corner against a middle pin of the other square.



**3** Use the loop method to start stitching (see page 88 for a tutorial) and whipstitch your way round the biscornu, joining each pair of opposite backstitches together. Take care not to skip stitches and not to catch the fabric with the needle.



**4** As you stitch on, your biscornu will start to take shape. Before you finish stitching it all around, insert your wadding. You can also add some dried flowers to gently scent your biscornu. Then sew up the final edge.



**5** Choose a couple of large buttons or beads to match your biscornu. Stitch them together, one each side of the biscornu, pulling tight on the cotton as you do so to create a dip in the centre of the biscornu.



**6** Now sit back and admire your work! You can use your biscornu as a pincushion, as we have in the photo, but it can also be used as a scissor fob, a cushion or simply as an ornament – the choice is yours!
